

Instructions For Use ARI_IFI I

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Enzyme Label Diluent

Description:


Enzyme Label Diluent was developed for use in immunochemical procedures. HRP labeled antibodies and avidin/streptavidin can be diluted directly in this reagent and can be stored for 18 months for Immunohistochemical uses when refrigerated. Higher dilutions may result in decreased shelf life. This product is subjected to 0.2µm filtration and contains a proprietary mixture of stabilizers and preservatives. This diluent does not contain sodium azide.

Appearance: Transparent liquid, slightly yellow. Discard if reagent becomes cloudy.

pH: 7.6±0.1

Uses/Limitations:

Not to be taken internally.
For In-Vitro Diagnostic use only.
Histological applications.
Do not use if reagent becomes cloudy.
Do not use past expiration date.
Use caution when handling reagents.
