Specificity: Recognizes EGP40, a 40-43kDa transmembrane epithelial glycoprotein, also identified as

epithelial specific antigen (ESA), or epithelial cellular adhesion molecule (Ep-CAM).

Background: It is expressed on baso-lateral cell surface in most simple epithelia and a vast majority of

carcinomas. This antibody has been used to distinguish adenocarcinoma from pleural mesothelioma and hepatocellular carcinoma. This antibody is also useful in distinguishing

serous carcinomas of the ovary from mesothelioma.

Species Reactivity: Human

Positive Control: MCF-7, HT29 cells or Ovarian carcinoma

Cellular Localization: Cell junction, Cell surface, Lateral cell membrane, Tight junction Titer/ Working Dilution: Immunohistochemistry (Frozen and Formalin-fixed): 1-2 µg/ml



Formalin-fixed, paraffin-embedded human colon carcinoma stained with EpCAM / CD326 Mouse Monoclonal Antibody (323/A3). HIER: Tris/EDTA, pH9.0, 45min. 2°C: HRP-polymer, 30min. DAB, 5min.

### Procedure:

- 1. **Tissue Section Pretreatment (Highly Recommended):** Staining of formalin fixed, paraffin embedded tissue sections is significantly enhanced by pretreatment with Tris-EDTA HIER Solution (10x) pH 9.0 (ScyTek catalog# TES500) or Citrate Plus (10x) HIER Solution (ScyTek catalog# CPL500).
- Primary Antibody Incubation Time: We suggest an incubation period of 30 minutes at room temperature.
   However, depending upon the fixation conditions and the staining system employed, optimal incubation should be determined by the user.
- 3. **Visualization:** For maximum staining intensity we recommend the "UltraTek HRP Anti-Polyvalent Lab Pack" (ScyTek catalog# UHP125, see IFU for instructions) combined with the "DAB Chromogen/Substrate Bulk Pack (High Contrast)" (ScyTek catalog# ACV500, see IFU for instructions).

**Precautions:** Contains Sodium Azide as a preservative (0.09% w/v).

Do not pipette by mouth.

Avoid contact of reagents and specimens with skin and mucous membranes.

Avoid microbial contamination of reagents or increased nonspecific staining may occur.
